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[1] The reason why the SungKongHoe University curriculum is special

Sungkonghoe University offers a variety of curricula to foster talented people who can respond to rapid social changes. It develops the ability to study and practice basic studies such as specialized liberal arts programs based on human rights, peace, and ecology, writing, and coding. In addition, after searching for a sufficient major through various basic major classes, choose a major course that suits your aptitude and career path.

✓ Provide sufficient opportunities for major exploration

Sungkonghoe University can choose a major suitable for aptitude and career after admission through specialized liberal arts courses and various basic majors. This provides an opportunity to experience systematic learning and major in advance, breaking away from the method of choosing a uniform major.

✓ A wide choice of majors

After exploring your major, you can freely choose the major you want. Based on systematic learning and major experience, you can choose the major you want to study in the future considering your aptitude. You can choose your major as you want without limiting the number of people and evaluating your grades.

✓ Mandatory multi-majoring

Sungkonghoe University has begun to reorganize its curriculum with the aim of fostering human resources with convergent thinking. First of all, you can freely choose one major you want regardless of your affiliation or department, and the other major you choose and study within the department you entered. Through free choice of major, you can lay the foundation for combining humanities and society and engineering, engineering and humanities and society. It also provides a special educational environment where you can complete two or more majors.

We would like to train IT professionals with system design skills and application program planning skills to develop high-tech devices such as smartphones and robots.

| Major of Software Engineering

■ Division of Global Studies (English Track)

- newly established March 2024

- Major of Digital Global Management for International Students

This Division is going to be officially started in the Spring Semester, 2024.

However, all the required courses for Global Division are open from the Autumn Semester, 2023, too. The courses described below are for the first year International Students in the first semester.

Introduction to Digital Global Management

This course introduces management principles, concepts, models, cases, and practices adopted by sustainable and effective global business firms. The topics of the course are as follows: principles of global management, types of global business firms, global entrepreneurship, global organization structure, global talent management, global business strategy, global marketing, global finance, global value chain, and global information management.

Seminar in Campas Life

This is required course to all the first year students at Sungkonghoe University, however, the course exclusively for the international students is specially organized by adviser of the international students. In the very beginning of the course, the students are strongly encouraged to submit their own designs and objectives for this course. All are collected by the advisers and the final course plan is decided.

Introduction of Information Technology

This course introduces basic concepts, logics and tools in Information Technology. The very basic computer languages required in Information Technology are to be taught in this course. The level of this course is just for the beginners.

Korean Culture and Society

This course helps the International Students settle down their lives in Korea. The topics studied in the course are as follows : Korean history, Korean culture and Korean civil society.

3. Eligibility to apply for special admission for international students

- ▶ As a pure foreigner (foreigner whose parents are both international students and who have graduated from a domestic or foreign high school course)
- ▶ A person who has obtained TOPIK level 3 or higher or IELTS 5.5 or higher (language grades are limited to valid grades)

※ Those who enter IELTS 5.5 or higher will later change their affiliation to the Division of Global Studies and those who enter TOPIK 3 or higher can choose from the Division of Global Studies or general undergraduate courses

1) Documents that are not written in Korean or English must be submitted by notarized translation.

- 2) In principle, all documents must be submitted in the original unless otherwise stated. However, if a copy is inevitably submitted, a copy of the original comparison of the issuing agency or the Embassy of the Republic of Korea or the consulate in the country must be submitted, or a copy of the original verification must be submitted with the original.
- 3) If a copy has been submitted, it must be replaced with the original after passing
- 4) If the name of the submitted document is different, a document certifying that it is the same person issued by the court of the relevant country or the head of the diplomatic mission must be attached.
- 5) Those who are scheduled to graduate after passing the final examination must submit their high school graduation certificate before the entrance date.
- 6) The final successful candidate must submit the final academic certificate (graduation certificate, enrollment certificate, and transcript of a school in a foreign country) after obtaining a "APPOSTYU confirmation" from the government agency of the country or a consular confirmation at the Korean consulate in the country.
- 7) You can request additional documents individually as needed.
- 8) Any documents submitted will not be returned.

7. Points to Note for Applicants for Special Admission for international students

- 1) If other illegal facts such as modification of submitted documents and entries or submission of false certificates are found, the acceptance or admission shall be canceled, and the admission fee shall not be refunded, and reported to relevant authorities. In this case, refunds of tuition fees already paid shall be processed in accordance with the Regulations for the Return of Tuition Fees and Admission Fees of Sungkonghoe University.
- 2) All documents necessary for admission application can be submitted with the original copies that have been verified against the original, but successful applicants must submit the original documents later, and documents that are not written in Korean or English must be notarized into Korean.

- 3) On the day of the examination, you must bring your identification card to confirm your identity.
- 4) If you pass more than one university, you must register at only one university, and if you double-register, all passes will be canceled.
- 5) If the contact information is changed during the examination period and the contact is lost due to the failure to report it to the admission information office of Sungkonghoe University, the examinee is responsible for this.
- 6) If you do not comply with the request for cooperation in the academic background inquiry, you may consider that there is a problem with your academic background and cancel your admission even after you enter the school.
- 7) Matters not specified in this outline shall be in accordance with the school rules and bylaws of the Seongkonghoe University. For more information on specific qualification standards and procedures, please contact the Sungkonghoe University International Affairs. (ryuji@skhu.ac.kr).
